Hello,

Since you're in the area, I'm letting you know about our regional AMC club, the **4 Seasons Rambler Club**. We are based in New England, and local members collectively own almost 200 AMC or related cars. Also, within our club, usually almost 1/2 of us are members of the worldwide American Motors Corp Rambler Club (**AMCRC**). We are open to **all years of AMC and its predecessors**, including AMC Jeep and Eagle (through Dec, 1987), Hudson, Rambler, Metropolitan, & Nash. We have been active since 1993, and we have been a chapter of the **AMCRC** since December of 1995. Many 4 Seasons members also belong to the AMCRC, the AMO, the NCCA, MOCNA, and the H.E.T. national clubs and/or their local chapters (as well as to some non-AMC clubs).

Members are located mostly in MA, CT, RI, ME, NH, VT, and NY. Through the membership, we try to provide local access to old car news, parts, vehicle repair services, and parts identifying & cross-referencing services. Membership is renewable on a **calendar year basis** - all members receive materials for the current year, then renew by January of the next year. Our standard dues are only **\$15 per year** for 5 newsletters, a roster, and other information. We also offer the option of our newsletters and roster to be delivered by either US mail or email. The advantages of email are lower cost (to keep dues as low as possible), faster delivery, full color, and saving hours of [my] printing / assembly / mailing time. The emailed version would be printed out on your own printer (in double-sided mode) to make a booklet. **Anyone subscribing to the email newsletter & roster will pay only \$10 for the year.**

Club meetings are informal. We hold a post-Christmas holiday party in January, an annual lunch gathering the Sunday following Easter, a season kickoff meeting / cookout the first Sunday in June (in northern CT), and we host a regional show at the end of July (this year in Windsor CT). Other meetings, shows, cookouts, and activities are scheduled as the need or as interest arises, are held in various central New England locations (about one per month). All are posted in our newsletter. Friends and family (bring kids, grandkids, parents, or grandparents) are welcome at any of the meetings, shows, or gatherings.
